In his books Khusairy describes bamboo as one of the green technologies responsible for ecoproducts and sees Sarawak, Malaysia as the ideal place to be a global source of bamboo. Khusairy's drive, passionate and expertise makes him an authoritive figure in his field and a valued Swinburne alarm, helping to create a better future for all.
