For students who were either: a) admitted into the Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma or Master of Business Information Systems suite in 2017 or 2018 or b) transitioned into one of the latter degree levels in 2017

To qualify for the award of Graduate Certificate of Information Systems students must complete 8 units of study (100 credit points) as follows:

- Seven (7) core units
- One (1) elective

To qualify for the award of Graduate Diploma of Business Information Systems students must complete 12 units of study (150 credit points) as follows:

- Nine (9) core units
- One (1) specialisation units
- Two (2) electives

To qualify for the award of Master of Business Information Systems students must complete 16 units of study (200 credit points) as follows:

- Ten(10) core units
- Three (3) specialisation units
- Three (3) electives

Students with a previous tertiary degree in IS or IT from a recognised institution and/or relevant work experience may be eligible for exemptions.

Regardless of any credit awarded within this degree, students must complete a minimum of 50% of the units with Swinburne University as part of this degree Suite.
