

Student Administration Application to be considered as a Pre-2008, Pre-2009 or Pre-2010 Commonwealth Supported Student



## WHO MUST COMPLETE THIS FORM

All students who are enrolling into a Commonwealth Supported (HECS) Place at Swinburne, who have previously been enrolled in a Higher Education course\*, must complete this form. The information supplied will be used to determine the correct fees for your enrolment under Australian Government legislation.

Your fee status will be assessed from the date of receipt of your application and will not be applied retrospectively.

\* A Higher Education course is an Associate Degree, Bachelor, Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma, Masters or Doctorate

# ELIGIBILITY FOR PRE-2008 STUDENT STATUS

## What does being a pre-2008 student mean?

- Students pay lower fees for accounting, administration, economics and commerce units than pre-2009, pre-2010 and Current Rate students, and
- Students pay higher fees for mathematic, statistics and science units than pre-2010 and Current Rate students, but the same as pre-2009 students.

### Who is eligible for a pre-2008 student status?

- Students who are enrolling into a Commonwealth Supported Place on or after 1 January 2009 and were enrolled in a Commonwealth Supported Place between 1 January 2005 and 31 December 2007 and either:
  - Did not complete the previous CSP course prior to 31 December 2007 or, if they did complete the previous course, the completed course was:
    - an enabling course undertaken in 2007, or
    - the related course for an honour's course in which the student is now enrolling, or
    - one of the degrees within a double degree enrolment and the student is continuing with the second degree<sup>1</sup>, or
  - o Completed the previous CSP course after 1 January 2008.
- Students who have taken a break from study remain eligible provided they meet the above requirements.
- Students must provide evidence of enrolment in a Commonwealth Supported Place during 1-Jan-05 and 31-Dec-07. Evidence may be in the form of a copy of a Commonwealth Assistance Notice showing dates of enrolment, SLE consumption and/or HECS-HELP debt, or a letter from the previous institution confirming enrolment dates in a Commonwealth Supported Place.
- All pre-2008 eligibility ends on 31 December 2012.

# Who is not eligible for a pre-2008 student status?

- A student who enrolled in a Commonwealth Supported Place before 1 January 2008 but withdrew from that course or deferred their enrolment, prior to the first census date of their enrolment, or completed their course prior to 31 December 2007 and the course was not one of the exceptions noted above.
- A student who was enrolled in a HECS Place prior to 1 January 2005 but who was not enrolled in a Commonwealth Supported Place between 1 January 2005 and 31 December 2007.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR PRE-2009 STUDENT STATUS

#### What does being a pre-2009 student mean?

- Students pay higher fees for accounting, administration, economics and commerce units than pre-2008 students, but the same as pre-2010 and Current Rate students, and
- Students pay higher fees for mathematic, statistics and science units than post-2009, but the same as pre-2008 students.

### Who is eligible for a pre-2009 student status?

 Students who were enrolled into a Commonwealth Supported Place prior to 1 January 2009 and are not eligible to be classified as pre-2008, pre-2010 or Current Rate student status.

## **ELIGIBILITY FOR PRE-2010 STUDENT STATUS**

#### What does being a pre-2010 student mean?

- Students pay higher fees for accounting, administration, economics and commerce units than pre-2008 students, but the same as pre-2009 and Current Rate students, and
- Students pay lower fees for education and nursing units than Current Rate students, and
- Students pay lower fees for mathematic, statistics and science units than pre-2008 and pre-2009 students, but the same as Current Rate students.

#### Who is eligible for a Pre-2010 student status?

- Students who enrolled into a Commonwealth Supported Place, prior to 1 January 2010, and:
  - o Did not complete the course by 31 December 2009, or
  - Completed the course but the course was an enabling course for current course, or
  - Completed the course but the course was a related course for an honours course and student is now undertaking the honours course.
- Students who have taken a break from study remain eligible provided they meet the above requirements.
- Students may be required to provide evidence of completion of their previous enrolment.
- Students enrolled in a double or combined degree that completed the requirements of only one of the awards on or before 31 December 2009
- Students enrolled in a single degree that transfer to a combined or double degree even if they complete the requirements of one of the awards.

## Who is not eligible for a pre-2010 student status?

 Students who have previously been enrolled in a Higher Education course and completed that course, except for the conditions stated above.

#### Who is not eligible for a pre-2010 student status?

- Students who were not a commonwealth supported student for a unit of study undertaken as part of a course of study before 1 January 2010 and withdrew prior to the census date for that unit.
- A student who studied as a HECS student prior to 1 January 2005 but who has not undertaken study between 1 January 2005 and 31 December 2009.

## PRIVACY STATEMENT
